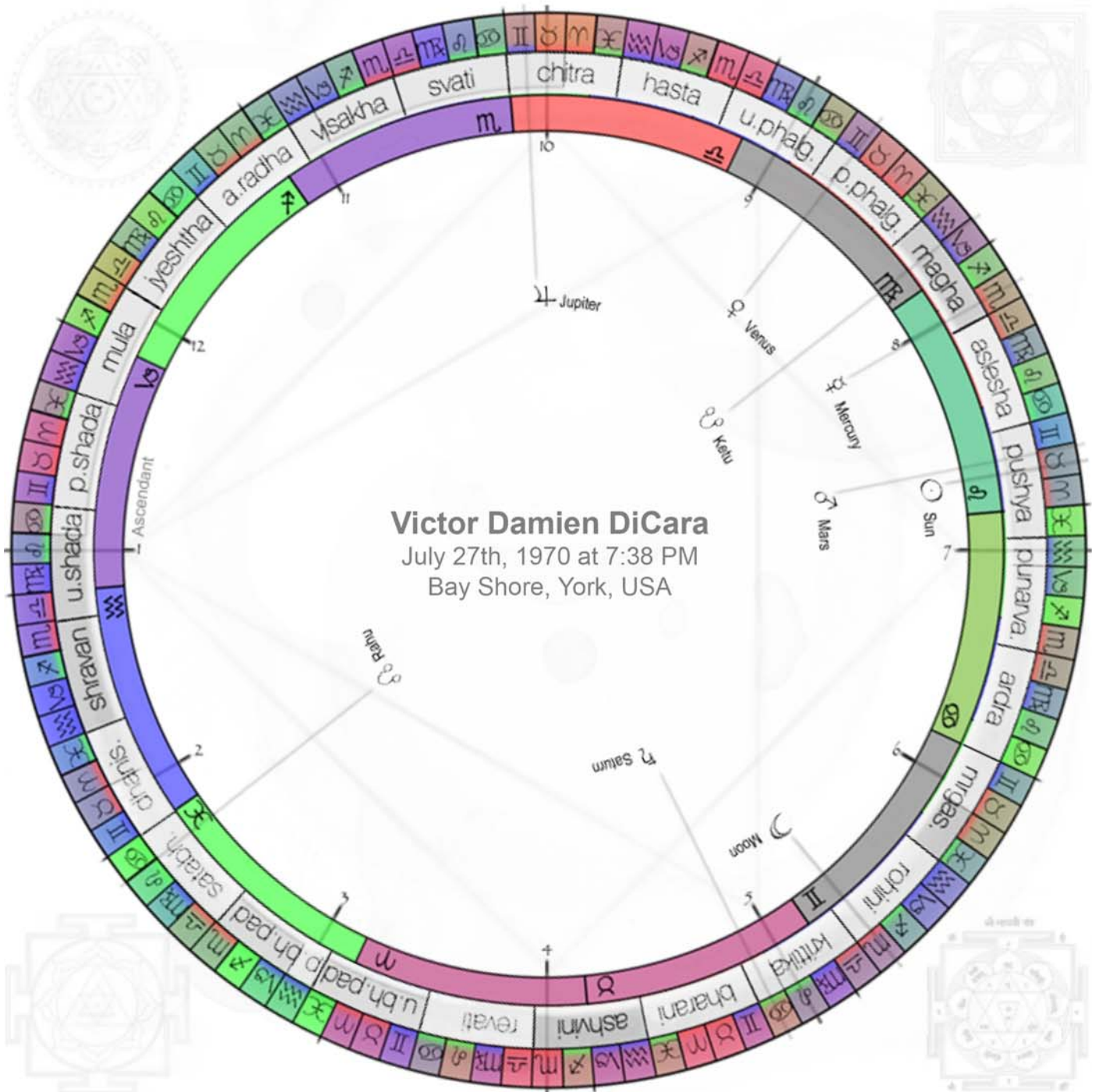


Your Signs



Above is a diagram of the heavens when you were born. The inner ring of the circle represents the twelve signs of the tropical zodiac (♈ - Aries, ♉ - Taurus, ♊ - Gemini, ♋ - Cancer, ♌ - Leo, ♍ - Virgo, ♎ - Libra, ♏ - Scorpio, ♐ - Sagittarius, ♑ - Capricorn, ♒ - Aquarius, and ♓ - Pisces). The outer ring are important subdivisions of the twelve signs, called *Navāmsā*. The middle ring represents the 27 stars of the sidereal zodiac. Inside the circle you can find the positions of the nine planets amidst the stars and signs.

About This Reading

The point of this reading is to help you better know yourself. I will recount to you the essential implications of destiny announced by each planet being in the sign it is in. This is a very simple way of giving a reading, but is very effective nonetheless, especially if you approach it calmly and with a patient and open mind. There are many, many things about your horoscope that this reading does *not* include. And those details surely narrow down and clarify what you will read here. But if you approach this with a meditative spirit you should be able to clarify many of those details on your own, using your own God-guided intuition.

I've made a basic attempt to sort your planets in a rough order of how dominant they are. I'll explain them in that order. I would expect that the qualities of the planets mentioned first would be more important than, and set the context for, the qualities of planets mentioned after. You can keep this in mind as you contemplate the reading deeply.

I describe your rising sign last, not because its the least important, but because its a good way to close the reading. I've tried to be as short and succinct as possible, so you don't have to wade through an ocean of words to get to the pertinent stuff.

Jupiter in Libra

Pleasant Appearance: Jupiter in Libra improves our beauty and fashion-sense.

Wealthy in Arts: More prosperity comes to us via arts like music, drama, literature, etc.

Scholarly: We have more faith in the value of knowledge and therefore make efforts to acquire learning and scholarship.

Saturn in Taurus

Unusual Beauty: Saturn in Taurus allows us to see beauty where others do not. Thus we are more often attracted to people and things that others find unappealing.

Modest in Needs: Saturn in Taurus reduces our needs for wealth and material prosperity.

Speech: Our words are challenged, reduced, held back, and more dirty.

The Moon in Gemini

Diplomatic: Moon in Gemini affords the ability to be like Mercury, a great negotiator, mediator, and diplomat. With smooth, balanced and persuasive words we are better able to solve problems and facilitate mutual prosperity between parties.

A side effect is that we prefer balanced, well rounded people. This extends as well to gender-dynamics.

Expert: Becoming like Mercury also means being intelligent, having ample knowledge at our disposal, and being versed and capable in expression through fine arts like music, dance, etc.

Fun-loving: Moon in Gemini increases our attraction to playing games and gambling. It makes us fonder of jokes and wit. It increases our enjoyment of the sense of touch, including sexual expertise.

Physical Effects: Moon in Gemini increases our beauty by improving the symmetry in our limbs and features. It causes our movements to be more graceful and attractive. It creates a lovely nose, makes the hair more curly, and causes the eyes to be more attractively playful.

Venus in Virgo

Servile: Venus in Virgo imparts a more keen sense that true pleasure comes by serving others and helping others enjoy their lives. A negative implication is a lack of fulfilling one's own needs, but a positive implication is improved selflessness.

Without Luxury: Venus in Virgo inclines us to live without comforts, pleasures and gratifications. The connotation need not be negative. It can also be a positive understanding that such things are not crucial to true happiness.

Mercury in Leo

Authoritative Intellect: We have an authoritative intelligence and speak with self-assured command.

A likely negative side-effect is that we evaluate things with authoritarian pride and stubbornness. This reflects in our words and turns people off. We become disliked. The negative effect particularly impacts those who must live and work intimately and cooperatively with us.

Royal Appetites: We can enjoy like royalty.

The downside is that royal enjoyment leads easily to disgrace and embarrassment. It also leads to debt, family problems, and a loss of simpler, truer pleasures.

Self-Taught: We can educate ourselves.

The harmful implication is that we are not comfortable in the role of a student, which limits

our appreciation for and access to education.

Mars in Leo

Self-Ruled: Mars in Leo grants us the ambition to be self-authorizing, self-governing, and self-disciplined. The likely negative ramification here is being overly independent to an extent that interferes with our ability to appreciate and function in relationships, partnerships, etc.

Further side effects include being without the accouchements of such cooperative relationships: including a fixed residence, clear roots, stable wealth, etc.

The Sun in Leo

Self-confident: The Sun in Leo generates an attractive, powerful, stable, and commanding identity.

Self-oriented Career: It enables careers in which self-confidence are essential: leadership positions, or positions in which ones personal self is the main commodity.

Truth seeking: It creates the inclination to seek truth and better awareness. The Sun, after all is the illuminator and is the soul. Yet it does not in itself incline us towards books and classrooms, rather it enables self-generated knowledge.

Rahu in Pisces

Rahu and Ketu are an axis. Wherever Rahu is, Ketu is always exactly opposite. So I will describe them together.

Rahu in Pisces pushes you away from the practical world and into an inspirational dream. It thrusts us headlong into the challenging struggle to make our real life more like our dreams and make our dreams more real. Eventually we realize balance by working hard in service to an inspirational cause. The entire dynamic coincidentally pushes us into a balance between practicality and spirituality.

Ketu in Virgo: Your previous lifetime focused on the importance of work. You worked very carefully and experienced that work well done brought you happiness, while work that was sloppily done did not. The present implication casts doubt on the meticulous work you are so familiar with. As a result you are impelled to seek deeper meaning in your daily routines and flirt with the desire to be freed from their tediousness.

Capricorn Rising

The rising sign determines the order of importance among the planets. So in a sense the effect of your rising sign permeates all throughout this reading. But it is also very, very useful to think of the rising sign as a "second Moon sign." In other words, the effect of Capricorn rising is nearly identical to the effects of the Moon in Capricorn, which are:

Detached: Detachment refers to emotional distance and the ability to be objective. So there is a coldness and dispassion enhanced by the Moon in Capricorn. This has several direct effects. It improves our ability to give up things that have lost their value. It increases our ability to endure situations that are difficult. And it makes us willing to do almost anything. These qualities can very easily combine to help us be more reliable, and thus improve our ability to support family.

Practical: Moon in Capricorn creates a mind more interested in realism and practicality. We can see flaws and faults and detect impossibilities more easily. We can spot fairy tales. Spirituality has to do with deep realities, so it certainly can attract the mind formed by Moon in Capricorn but, in contrast, mass *religion* strikes such a mind as being too unrealistic.

Critical: A Capricorn Moon allows the mind to feel at home in a critical environment.

Misc.: The cardinal mode of Capricorn empowers the mind to think more ambitious thoughts. The enduring natures of earth and Saturn in this sign strengthen the mind, making it more retentive and prudent. The careful, critical, and retentive mind enabled by Moon in Capricorn is well suited to many long, slow, difficult tasks.

Physical Effect: Lean, thin legs, slender waist, graceful eyes, sensitive to cold.
